INT. RON'S OFFICE

Two shot

RON

He was supposed to have my monologue for tonight's show to me an hour ago.

JAMES

That's not like him. I'll go check.

James walks down the hallway while camera zooms slowly. James stops at the equipment room door. When he does the zoom stops.

JAMES (CONT'D)

Oh my god!

James enters the equipment room.

CUT TO:

INT CHRIS' OFFICE

James is staring in disbelief. After a beat Ron arrives at the door.

RON

What? What is it James?

James points toward the desk.

CUT TO:

INT. CHRIS' OFFICE

Reverse two shot of stunned James and Ron. Camera zooms out slowly.

JAMES

It's the worst case of writers block I'm ever seen.

Reveal CHRIS at a computer with a box/block covering his head and one on each hand. His hands are moving over the keyboard but not touching it.

FADE OUT.

NOTES ON THE BLOCK

I have a square box at work that will work for the head. For the hands the only thing I can think of are those square-ish kleenex boxes.

If all of the boxes can be painted to resemble granite or covered with some granite type coloring that would be great. The thing is they just can't be boxes so if that can't be done neither can this. It would kill the comedy if there was just a box on a head and two kleenex boxes on hands.
