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INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

James reaches over and takes a potato chip out of the bag. Everything seems very normal as the title of the show pops up:

James pops the chip in his mouth and chews it while watching TV. All during this time he calmly changes channels. We hear snippets of all the programs.

After he chews the chip he reaches back into the bag and pulls out a Dorito.

Now I think you're in total understanding of the concept.

He pulls out corn chips, meatball, slice of ham, cheese, a piece of birthday cake, spoonful of ice cream, orange slice, nuts, chocolate, whatever. James never looks at the table or the food he's eating. He never takes his eyes off the TV.

Near the end of the half hour (or however long but, come on, pulling this off for half an hour would be insane) James looks at his watch, yawns and stands. The camera pulls back to reveal the empty snack bag with no evidence that anything went Twilight Zone. James picks up the empty bag, turns off the TV and exits.

FADE TO BLACK.

Note: The only issue I see is keeping the person on the floor handing James the snacks out of the shot. But I don't think it'll be a big issue.
